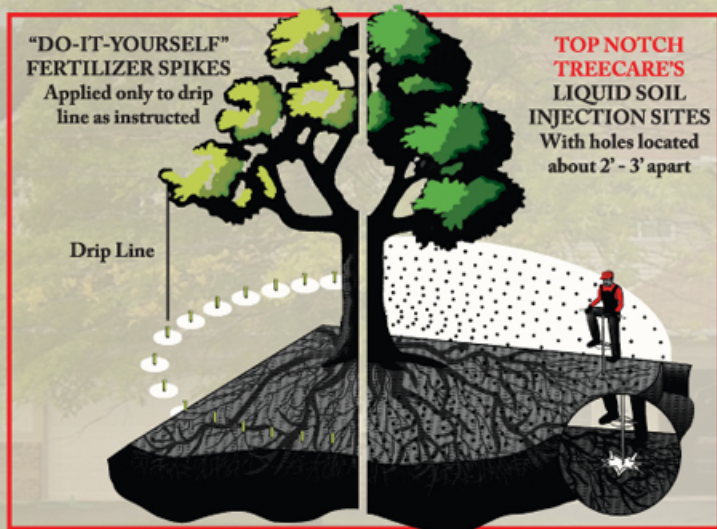
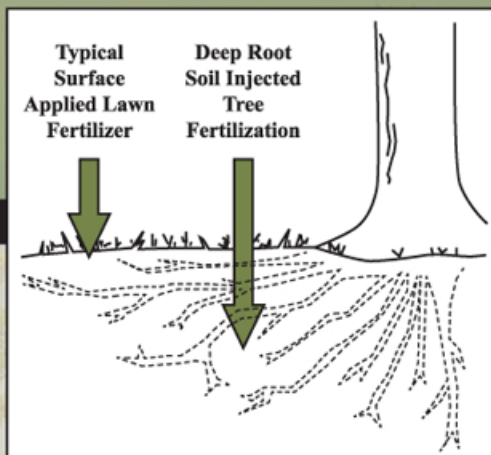


Fertilization

Lawn Fertilization is NOT the same as Tree Fertilization

Trees need nutrients from the soil to survive. In the urban setting, soils are rarely replenished with any organic matter, the main source of mineral nutrition.

Plants lacking in nutrition will not reach their full landscape potential; they may survive, but not thrive.



Plants deficient in one or more essential nutrients often show symptoms such as:

- Stunted Branch Growth
- Leaf Discoloration
- Small Leaf Size
- Leaf Distortion
- Twigs Dieback
